Points Keeper Contract

August 03, 2007

In this contract 8oaksshowservices will be known as the Contractor and Perfected Technology Systems will be know as the Sub Contractor. The contract will go through January 15, 2011.

The method for individual class and high point tabulations will be consistent with the current CCC Operating Guidelines.

All horses meeting CCC guideline requirements will be tracked, to include sponsored and non-sponsored classes (notation on non-sponsored classes required on state standings)

Method of tabulation for State High Point awards will be in compliance with CCC guidelines.

Any individual may request summary of their points, or their competitors (one horse, one rider).

Submission of results by individual clubs will be in a format consistent with pointkeeper requirements.

Contractor will track all Perpetual and Memorial Trophy categories as outlined in the California Paint Horse Directory. Contractor is responsible for submitting year-end results and club membership data to directory publisher by December 1. Contractor will provide membership labels to individual clubs upon request at a cost of \$35 per set , no cost if e-mailed.

Contractor will attend CCC meetings as requested by CCC at no expense to CCC.

State standings will be up dated within 14 days of receipt of official show results from the individual club show secretary.

Contractor will track and report horse ownership and club membership dates as required in CCC operating guidelines.

CCC will advance an initial payment to contractor in the amount calculated as \_ of the amount of the previous year contract amount. The final payment for the show year is due no later then February 1 of the following year. Rate to be .75 per horse per judge. (Contractor to get .25 per horse per judge, Sub Contractor to get .50 per judge.). Payment to sub contractor will be due no later then 2 weeks from contractor's receipt of payment.

Contractor will be responsible for training back up personnel in the event of contractor being unable to perform duties as specified in contract.

Sub Contractor agrees to provide software and support throughout the year insuring that show results can be reported in a timely manner for members to review high point standings. Sub Contractor would also agree to provide program modifications to insure the point keeping software conforms to the rules of CCC as currently defined for the year 2004.

Sub Contractor retains the rights to publish the State Points on a web site provided by the sub contractor. Web sites belonging to members of CCC may include a link to the sub contractor's web site and a return link back to CCC's web site, but may not have a "Window" into the sub contractor's web site as this has been deemed confusing by members of CCC.

Clubs are responsible for all information needed to do points such as Youth birthdays, Youth ID numbers, Amateur ID numbers and owners addresses. As not all of this information appears on the APHA disk. The results will be sent back if all of this information is not in the report.

Each party of this contract retains the right to terminate this contract with 30 days written notice of intent to terminate. If the contract is terminated a pro-rated payment will be due and payable to the contractor and sub contractor within 30 days of the termination date of the contract.
