

**CCC Horseman of the Year  
Nominee: Sandee Proctor**

San Joaquin Paint Horse Club feels that Sandee Proctor, through her voluntary services, more than fulfills the requirements to be named CCC Horseman of the Year. Therefore San Joaquin Paint Horse Club is truly honored to nominate Sandee for her unwavering dedication to the promotion of Paint Horses and for promoting of the Paint Horse Clubs within the state for over 25 years.

Sandee began her equestrian career as a youth showing Western (equitation, pleasure, trail and stock horse classes) and English (Hunt Seat equitation, pleasure, and jumping). In 1963, she opened her own stable where she bred and showed Quarter Horses. She showed one of her mares to Grand Champion Mare honors at the Cow Palace. Sandee also became an accredited judge with what was then known as the American Horse Shows Assoc.

In the 1970's, Sandee was asked to show the Paint stallion, 21 Jewels, and from that time on, she has focused her attention strictly to Paint Horses and their promotion. Sandee has shown horses to club and state titles including Miss Sierra Splash, An Original Copy, Ultimately Mine, HF Skips Cinnamon, Victorrific, Rock Around, Nobleman, Im Twice As Nice, Truly Obsessed, Believe N Achieve, and Always A Gentleman just to name a few.

In 1999, Sandee saw a need for Paint exhibitors to access crucial CCC information in a more timely manner and she created and developed Horseservices.com, an online equine business directory web site that offers free web sites to CCC and California regional clubs. In the past, exhibitors waited for state points and messages to be published in a monthly paper periodical and the points were always thirty to forty-five days behind. Online information has enabled Paint Horse owners and exhibitors to be more informed and connected to CCC, clubs and show management.

During her career Sandee has dedicated countless volunteer hours by creating club newsletters, show premiums and club forms. Sandee has served as the Northern California Championship Circuit chairperson for several years, including being the current chairperson. She has served as Sierra Paint Horse Club President for three terms, and is the current Secretary. Sandee served on the CCC board for eight years and served as CCC secretary for six years -- never missing a meeting. She currently serves as a member of the Equine Medication Monitoring Committee for the State of California representing the California Paint industry.

Sandee has dedicated many years to promoting, educating and volunteering her time to the Paint Horse industry in the State of California and still finds the time to exhibit horses at numerous shows through the year. She is most deserving of the title of Horseman of the Year for California.
