

Directors report Workshop 2011—Gwen Russell Rules Committee

At workshop this year several new items and ideas were proposed. Some were not put through for vote at convention. A popular proposal was the Performance Halter, this did not get through. Another proposal to change youth walk-trot to 5-10 did finally pass to be voted on at convention. One controversial proposal to allow Crop-out Quarter Horses to be register has passed to convention. This one was very close with a petition being signed to forward this proposal.

There is also a proposal to allow up to five(5) horses be shown by one exhibitor, in trail, western riding, reining, working cowhorse, cutting, hunter hack, jumping, and roping events. This could make our numbers in classes better and also allow trainers who only train in one field to show more horses.

There was vote to keep workshop and convention two separate meetings.
