

**NCCC Meeting  
May 18, 2009**

The meeting was called to order at 7:05pm by Chairperson Lindy Williams at Stonebrooks restaurant in Sacramento. Attending were: Lindy Williams, Chairperson (SPHC); Bob Lentz, Vice-Chairperson (7-CPHC); Ellen deLong, Secretary (CPHA); Jan Teisseire (SJPHC). Janet Radford and Gwen Russell were excused. Guests were Katy Lentz and Walter Jarrett.

Motion to approve the minutes of the last meeting was made by Bob Lentz, 2nd by Jan Teisseire. Motion passed.

Treasurer report: As of April, 2009, there is \$2,064.49 in the NCCC account. Kelly Waugh was absent, but sent a balance sheet.

Old Business: The web site is being up-dated and looks very nice. The back cover was bought by Lentz Repair. Dianna Phillips is the points keeper this year. The vote to raise club assessment fees from \$200.00 to \$250.00 passed with the vote being as follows: CPHA-yes; SPHC-yes; 7-CPHC-yes; NPHC-yes; SJPHC-no; NCPHC-didn't vote. The All-Around reserve award was sponsored by SPHC, so will be given this year. There was clarification on NCCC lead-line (no horse needs to be nominated), and on the 3 year-old performance class.

New Business: There are 35 members and 46 horses nominated as of May 18, 2009. Checks are being held for 5 people while waiting for copies of registration papers. Discussion of the NCCC Mothers Cup ensued and a motion was made by Bob Lentz, and 2nd by Ellen deLong, to end this award in 2010. This will be taken back to the clubs for a vote and will be reported back at our next meeting.

The next NCCC meeting is Nov. 2, 2009 at 7:00pm at Stonebrooks restaurant on Bercut Dr. in Sacramento.

Motion to adjourn was made by Jan Teisseire, 2nd by Ellen deLong. Motion passed and the meeting was adjourned at 7:26 pm.
